The Brisbane Hockey Management Group Inc (BHMGI) is a joint organisation of Brisbane Hockey Association (BHA), Brisbane Women's Hockey Association (BWA) and Kedron Wavell Services Hockey Club (KWSHC) and was established to assume the operation and management of Brisbane North Hockey Centre - Burringbar Park at Chermside.

BHMGI is a non-for-profit organisation striving to serve its members and is interested in partnering with companies and like-minded community organisations for a mutual benefit.

OUR MEMBERS

With more than 5000 players in the Brisbane region participating in the sport of hockey, Burringbar Park has become the premier hockey facility and is a major hub for training and match fixtures for some 20 clubs with over 200,000 spectators annually attending fixtures at the centre.

COMPETITIONS

Brisbane Hockey Season (March to September).

The Centre hosts fixture competitions for Junior Girls and Junior Boys, Senior Men and Senior Women, as well as Men's Masters and Women's Masters.

Matches are played on Monday & Tuesday Nights for Masters, Friday Night and Saturday Mornings for Juniors and Saturday afternoon and Sunday afternoon for our Senior members.

Brisbane Summer Hockey Season (October to December).

We have a thriving Summer Social Hockey Competition, with teams currently registered to play across Juniors and Seniors. Games are played on week nights and Saturday Mornings.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENT AND UPGRADE

At Burringbar Park, Brisbane North Hockey Centre's first synthetic turf field was completed in May 2001.

In partnership with the three tiers of Government (Local, State and Federal), BHMG has worked to expand this local sporting precinct by constructing a much needed second synthetic turf field which was completed in August 2019.

The completion of this turf field better caters for the numerous hockey teams that train and play at this complex. It has reduced crowding and ensures all players have a safe environment to train and play but more importantly has helped to encourage the growth of our sport.

Brisbane North Hockey Centre currently hosts the local Men's Masters 9's competition as well as the U18 pre-season junior competition "THE WOLF CUP" in February each year.

With two Synthetic Turf pitches, BNHC now has the ability to host major tournaments including State and National Titles as well as attracting International Matches. Over the coming years, BNHC will host the State Titles for the U18 Women in July and the U18 Men's State Titles being held at the facility the following year.





BRISBANE NORTH HOCKEY CENTRE—TURF FENCE SIGNAGE

- Signs can be approximately 1900mm (l) and 820mm (h) Spanning one fence panel.
- Sponsors are to produce and pay for their sign. Our preferred sign writer is Eco-Printing info@ecoprinting.com.au (if required)
- The sign is to be constructed of metal with rubber backing or other agreed material.
- Positioning will be based on availability of sites.
- No Sponsorship signs are to be located on the buildings.

THE COST

- Annual Cost is \$440.00 (Price includes GST).
- Annual fee will be invoiced in January each year.
- New Sponsors will pay a pro rata from the time of approval to December 31st.
- Established Sponsors will be contacted in October each year to confirm their commitment for the following year.

THE PROCESS

- To have a sign put up at the facility, please email the BHMG secretary at secretary@brishockey.org.au requesting a site on the fence, with a color depiction of the sign. or apply online.
- Once approval has been given by the Board, you will be invoiced for the sign location and term.
- Once payment has been received the approved sign can be produced and provided to the BHMG Facility Manager for placement. Contact John Goodall on 0417 814 208.
- The cost to repair or replace the sign is at the advertiser's cost.
- Signs will be removed at the end of the agreed period.
